


## MULTIPASS Strategy

The teacher needs to walk the students initially through the parts of the MULTIPASS strategy. Depending on the skill level of the students, each section can be taught individually or the guide sections can be taught as a whole.



### Survey Pass

1. Student looks for the main ideas and details using: the title, captions under the headings and pictures.



### Size-Up Pass

2. Student looks for specific information in the reading without reading it from beginning to end. Looking for vocabulary words in bold or italic; skimming the text; looking at the questions at the end of the reading or guide questions made up by the teacher.



### Sort-Out Pass

3. Student reads and answers the questions at the end of the chapter or those on the MULTIPASS reading guide.
